NEWS FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As most of us are aware, Archbishop Damphousse has decided to create a pastoral unit with St. Columban and St. Francis parish. As was explained, both parishes will continue to be independent parishes with their own finance councils and all celebrations that are particular to the parish will be celebrated in the parish of your choice. There will be separate Finance Councils, but only one Pastoral Council. The pastoral needs of the parish will be looked after by two priests, Msgr. Kevin Maloney will be pastor of both parishes and Fr. Steven Gaudet will be the assistant in both parishes.

The Sunday mass schedule will remain as it is, and there will be no changes in either parish at this time. The weekday mass schedule, however, will be changing. There will be a weekday mass at 8:00 a.m. at St. Francis on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. There will be a weekday mass at St. Columban at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesdays, Thursdays and the First Saturday of the month. There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on the First Friday of the month from 7:00 a.m. until mass at 8:00 a.m. at St. Francis. These changes will take effect on 1st August; that means that on Thursday, 1st August the mass will be at 8:00 a.m. at St. Columban, and on First Friday, 2nd August, the Adoration and Mass will be at St. Francis.

Confessions will continue on the normal schedule at St. Columban - 3:00-3:45 p.m. and at St. Francis 3:30-4:30 p.m. Funerals and weddings will take place in either churches according to the request of the family. It is my hope that as we begin this new venture that the parishioners of both parishes will be able to work together pastorally to embrace the mission of the Church, namely, go out to all the world to proclaim the Good News.
