ADORATION CHANGE – JULY, AUGUST

There will be no First Friday Adoration in July and August.

REMINDER

Once again, I would like to remind all parishioners that, effective the first weekend of August, we are creating a new pastoral unit between St. Columban Parish and St. Francis. This will mean there will be some small changes in the WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE. On 1st August, the weekday mass will be at 8:00 a.m. at St. Columban. On 2nd August, the First Friday, we will have adoration at 7:00 a.m. followed by mass at 8:00 a.m. at St. Francis. The weekend mass schedule will remain unchanged at the present time.

MASS INTENTIONS

We have received permission, because of the creation of the new pastoral unit, that masses that have already been designated in either parish for a particular date will be celebrated on the dates that they have been promised, even if it means that there will be two mass intentions for that day. This permission is granted only for masses that have been scheduled already, and in the future, the normal practice of one scheduled mass intention per day will be followed. An important note would be that if your mass was scheduled for a Thursday, it would be celebrated at St. Columban and not at St. Francis.

POWER PRAYER

The parish currently has openings for your Mass Intention. Do you have something to be thankful for? Does someone you know need prayers? Are you praying for a special need? Having a mass said allows our parish community to offer their prayers along with you for your intention. We don't have to be alone in prayer. We welcome all those who would like to have a mass or several masses said for their intentions.



THE SANCTUARY LAMP

The sanctuary lamp is a special lamp kept close to the Tabernacle. The sanctuary lamp remains alight to indicate and honour the presence of Christ. The living flame of the sanctuary lamp signifies the Eucharistic presence of our Lord Jesus Christ. Sponsorship of the Sanctuary Lamp is available for a week-long period. The stipend is \$20.00 per week, and the intention will be listed in the bulletin.
