IN OUR PARISH

REMINDER

Once again, I would like to remind all parishioners that, effective the first weekend of August, we are creating a new pastoral unit between St. Columban Parish and St. Francis. This will mean there will be some small changes in the WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE. On August 12th, 14th, and 16th the weekday Mass will be at 8:00 a.m. at St. Francis. On August 13th, and 15th the Mass will be at 8:00 a.m. at St. Columban. The weekend mass schedule will remain unchanged at the present time.

MASS INTENTIONS

We have received permission, because of the creation of the new pastoral unit, that masses that have already been designated in either parish for a particular date will be celebrated on the dates that they have been promised, even if it means that there will be two mass intentions for that day. This permission is granted only for masses that have been scheduled already, and in the future, the normal practice of one scheduled mass intention per day will be followed. An important note would be that if your mass was scheduled for a Thursday, it would be celebrated at St. Columban and not at St. Francis.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

SAINT MAXIMILIAN KOLBE

Saint Maximilian was born in Poland in 1894. As a Franciscan, he worked to spread the Gospel in his native Poland as well as in Japan. He had a great devotion to Our Lady.

During the Nazi occupation of Poland, he helped thousands of refugees, including Polish Jews. He was arrested by the Gestapo in 1941 and imprisoned at Auschwitz. Three months after Maximilian's arrival, a prisoner escaped. In retaliation, 10 men were chosen at random to die. One was a young father; Maximilian offered to take his place. His offer accepted, Maximilian died on August 14 in 1941 and was canonized in October 1982. Living with Christ
