## SACRAMENTS OF HEALING - PART 3

The two previous articles about the Anointing of the Sick presented its importance in Christ's ministry and indicated who might receive the sacrament. This article will explain how the sacrament will be celebrated.

The service, which will begin at 3:00 p.m., we will have music, prayers, a Gospel reading and a reflection. The sacrament will be administered with two gestures. The first will be a prayer requesting the Holy Spirit to bring healing to everyone who is present. Secondly, those who wish to be anointed will be invited to come forward and the priest will lay his hands upon their head and anoint their forehead and the palms of their hands. For those who have mobility problems, we will go to them so that they do not have to stand too long. After everyone has had the opportunity to be anointed, there will be a final prayer and blessing.

We encourage you to invite family and friends to join us in this celebration. Please note that it will be a **prayer service** (not Mass) with the Anointing of the Sick on **Sunday, June 8 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Columban's Church.**
