SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

An important part of Christ's ministry was the ministry of healing. The Gospels are full of stories of many miracles that Jesus performed. Some were physical healings, and some were spiritual healings (the forgiveness of sins and the casting out of evil spirits). The Church has maintained the importance of this ministry by celebrating two sacraments of healing.

Most people are well aware of the sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance or Confession). But, are we equally aware and familiar with the other sacrament of healing, namely "the Anointing of the Sick"?

For too many of us this sacrament has been considered to be the sacrament of the dying, but in reality, this sacrament was meant to be a sacrament of healing. It is not meant to be offered only when we are dying, but a sacrament which works alongside with medical science to pray for healing for those who are seriously ill of mind or body.

In February of 2024, St. Francis de Sales held a prayer service (not Mass) conferring this sacrament. This year, in order to accommodate all who are seeking healing, the prayer service for healing (not Mass) with the Anointing of the Sick will be offered on **Sunday, June 8 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Columban's Church**. We encourage you to invite family and friends to join us in this celebration.
