BISHOP'S CHAIR (SC)

The Finance Council would like to thank the St. Columban's Catholic Women's League for the generous donation to have the Bishop's Chair repaired. The chair was re-webbed on the underside of the seat by Pierre Lefebvre Upholstery Inc. Mr. Lefebvre provided the following information. The chair is an Eastlake Chair manufactured in 1898. Eastlake lived around St. Louis. He designed furniture, and the manufacturer would have bought the design from him. The chair was repaired using the same technique used in its manufacture.

SAINT OF THE WEEK – JULY 22ND

SAINT MARY MAGDALENE

Since the 6th century, Western tradition has linked three gospel accounts as referring to one woman, although some notable writers are undecided.

Luke relates that an unnamed sinner who anointed the Lord's feet received forgiveness of her many sins because of her great love. He also writes that among the women who travelled with Jesus and the apostles was Mary Magdalene, who had been exorcised of seven devils. Mary Magdalene was a faithful follower of the Lord. With the other women, she stood near the cross, brought spices to anoint the body and alone, weeping with grief, was the first witness to the resurrection of Christ. Mary Magdalene is a patron of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans).
