## SAINT OF THE WEEK – JULY 30<sup>TH</sup>

### SAINT PETER CHRYSOLOGUS

Peter, born in Italy around 406, became Archbishop of Ravenna about 439. When he arrived in his diocese, he found a strong pagan influence and many lapsed faithful. Through his labours, paganism was eradicated and the faith revised. He was a concerned pastor and preacher and earned the title Chrysologus ("of golden words") because of his inspirational homilies, many of which are still extant. He died around 450 and was made a Doctor of the Church in 1729.
