## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Our sessions have now begun for First Confession. Thanks to our Sacramental Preparation Team for sharing their gifts and helping parents and children grow in faith. First Communion will take place after Easter. Confirmation is tentatively scheduled for February with an all-day retreat on January 17, led by NET Ministries.

Catholic schools exist to assist committed families, and their parishes celebrate and live their faith in our communities. But people sometimes say this triad of school, church and family is no longer functional. Yes, it can be challenging to keep all the partners working in harmony, but it is a challenge worth fighting for.

Every Catholic parent is entrusted with "homeschooling" their child with the things of faith, the virtues, Christian living, God's love, and their primary human formation.

Much criticism is spoken of public education. But there is little emphasis on the domestic Church and the "school years" of home and faith's first learning place. Don't just desire to run "away" from public education. Most worthy is the pressing task of carrying children to Jesus. Again, thanks to our parish leaders for making this possible through our Sacramental Preparation Team.
