FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Missing Piece" Series

Week Three: Inner Peace.

In the Gospel, John the Baptist sends his disciples to Jesus to ask if he is truly the Messiah. John had spent his life preparing the way for Jesus, but now that he is in prison, he is agitated and lacks peace. He wonders if his work had been in vain. Jesus points to all the signs that he is the Messiah by the work he is doing. When we lack peace in our hearts, we can turn to Jesus and see the good works he does and invite him to do the same for us.

- Know? Advent is a season of hope, and at its heart is the promise of peace. God desires not only peace in the world but peace within our own hearts. Yet peace often feels elusive, whether because of sin, worry, or circumstances beyond our control. The life of John the Baptist reminds us that even great men of faith can feel unsettled, yet the path forward is to turn our worries to God. Real peace is not found in the absence of trouble but in the presence of God.
- Feel? This message invites us to feel both understood and encouraged. We are not alone in our anxieties, doubts, or struggles. Just as John wrestled with worry in prison, we too can bring our unsettled hearts to the Lord. We are invited to feel the hope and reassurance that God is present with us and that His peace surpasses anything the world can offer.
- Next steps? We are called to actively seek peace by growing in faith through conversation with God. When circumstances disturb us, we can follow St. Paul's teaching: bring everything to God in prayer with thanksgiving. Beginning with gratitude, even before we see answers, shows our trust in Him. This Advent, we are encouraged to set aside worry, turn consistently to prayer, and allow God's peace to guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.
